Vegetable of the Month – Margaret on Growing Asparagus

Guest Speaker- David will show us 'A year in the Garden' with photos of his own garden to demonstrate crop rotation etc. **Garden Visit on 14**th **January at 2pm**

Margaret Scott's 103 Main South Rd,

East Taieri. There is not a lot of parking on site. There is some parking on the Main Road. Car Pooling at Strathallen Street outside Bunnings carpark.

One of the nicest salads A bit of work but I do a double batch of nuts as they store is an airtight container and do a pot of chickpeas and freeze them in 2 cup lots so it is easier

Chickpea, Beetroot and Nut Salad.

For the Salad mix % cup dried chickpeas soaked and then cooked until tender with ½ a tsp of turmeric or 2 cups cooked chick peas I cook in a pot with some turmeric

1 medium beetroot cut into matchsticks, rinsed and set aside to dry off.

- 1 large carrot cut into match sticks'
- 4 spring onions sliced
- 2 sticks of celery diced
- 1 thumb of fresh ginger very thinly sliced
- ½ cup coarsely chopped parsley
- 1 cup coriander leaves

Toss all the ingredients together setting aside ½ the coriander leaves to use as a garnish.

For the nut mix

2 cups mixture of peanuts, cashews, sunflower seeds, pumpkin seeds and seseme

2 Tble brown sugar, ½ tsp each of salt, cumin, and coriander powder

¼ tsp chilli powder

Mix these ingredients together

25 gm chilled butter.

Bake the nuts and seeds for 5 minutes at 1800 C then sprinkle with the mixture of spices, salt and brown sugar. Grate the butter over and bake for 10 more minutes stirring often. Set aside to cool

For **the dressing and to serve**

3 Tbles balsamic vinegar ½ tsp brown sugar Salt and freshly ground black pepper ½ cup of olive oil

Mix all the ingredients toss the vinaigrette and 2/3 of the nut mixture Garnish with the remaining nuts and coriander. Serves 8-10 people (according to the recipe)

GARDEN TASKS FOR January 2017

Sow seeds of: Beetroot, Carrots, Cauliflower, Cabbage, Celery, Kale, Kohlrabi, Leeks, NZ Spinach, Peas, Salsify, and Silver Beet, and Coriander. Sprouting Broccoli, Radishes, Lettuces, Swedes, White turnips and purple topped turnips, Spring Onions, and Bok Choi

Plant seedlings of:

Basil, Lettuces, silver beet, spinach, and Spring onions. All brassica's; Broccoli, Brussels sprouts, Cabbages, Cauliflower, Kohl rabi, Kale also Celery and Leeks.

Moon Planting January 2017

January 2nd to 9th –sow and plant above the ground

16th and 17th— root planting 24th and 25th - root planting

February the 1st to 9th – sow above ground crops
